ADVOCATE

The Chapter is a member of the **Tampa Chamber of Commerce.** Emily Farkas is a member of their Military Affairs Committee (MAC) and Policy Advisory Committee (PAC). As a member of the PAC, Emily has advocated this past year for "increase pay for lower tier enlisted grades", which is one of AFA's national goals, as a top item for the Tampa Chamber of Commerce for 2025. The Chapter has also recently joined the **Tampa Bay Defense Alliance (TBDA).** We attend their monthly meetings to provide insight into the AFA goals in the Tampa area.

EDUCATE



The Waterman-Twining Chapter supports the USF AFROTC detachment, and especially the **Arnold Air Society** unit. Within our Chapter area, there are **11 AFJROTC units** and each year, AFA provides a Cadet of the Year Award, and Chapter members attend to present the Award. We have also reached out to local **Civil Air Patrol (CAP) units**. The Chapter

promotes and supports the AFA National STEM Programs of **StellarXplorers and CyberPatriot**. In addition, **Stewart Middle School** is a NASA Explorer STEM Magnet
School, and the Chapter has directly supported them for many years. This year, we will

be directly supporting STEM initiatives at **Tinker K8 School, located on MacDill AFB**. Finally, each year we select an outstanding teacher

for an AFA Chapter Teacher of the Year (TOY) Award. Finally, we present the Pitsenbarger Award to the Outstanding CCAF graduate each semester.





SUPPORT

The Waterman-Twining Chapter works to support the airmen, guardians, and their families assigned to MacDill AFB. One way to do this is by supporting the AFA's United Forces and Families (F2) Program. The Chapter has partnered with MacDill's Family Readiness Center to support their spouse events. In addition, we attend the monthly MacDill Newcomers Briefing and showcase how our Chapter supports MacDill AFB members and their families. The Waterman-Twining Chapter is also proud to partner with the Blue Star Families organization, which





sponsors several events throughout the year to support military families and Chapter members

volunteer to assist them. The Chapter has also partnered with the **Family in Flight nonprofit**, which provides travel grants to unite separated families, plus a place for connection and support, including monthly virtual support groups to helpful tools and shared stories, to remind military families that they are not alone.
